
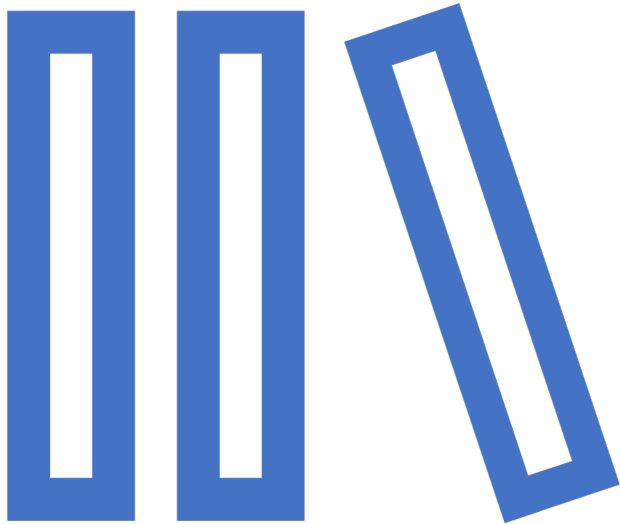

What is the Library of Congress Surplus Program?

- The Library of Congress has available at all times, for donation to eligible organizations and institutions, surplus books which are not needed for the Library's own uses.

Who is eligible?

- Eligible organizations and institutions must be located in the United States and fall into one of the following categories:
- Full-time, tax-supported or nonprofit educational institution: school, school system, college, university, museum, or public library.
- Agency of local, state, or federal government.
- Nonprofit institution or organization that has tax-exempt status under the provisions of section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (see 41 CFR 101-44.207 (a)(17)) and that operates a library and/or research center open to the public.

- Participating organizations must select materials in-person at the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C. Organizations from outside the area may designate a local individual to act on its behalf.
- Library of Congress staff members, though, are prohibited from making selections on behalf of participating organizations.
