



- The very act of questioning media can be weaponized.


What might be the answer?

- Find cognitive glitches (Seek, find, and fill them in)
- Read the text of speeches/news. Keep an emotional distance


Technology Typically Goes Two Ways







Takeaways



- Twenty-two percent reported a decrease in budget since 2016-17.
 Ten percent had an increase. The overall change was negligible at -0.4 percent.
- Nearly one in five librarians said a change in school leadership impacted their budget.
- Three-quarters of school librarians spent an average of \$302 of their own money on the library. Books, supplies, prizes/incentives, and decorations were the most notable items.
- Just about half of school librarians have restrictions on what they can spend their LMC budget on, no matter what grade level.
- Private schools have an average budget twice as high as the national average, but they include a higher proportion of high schools.


