Searching as Strategic Exploration:

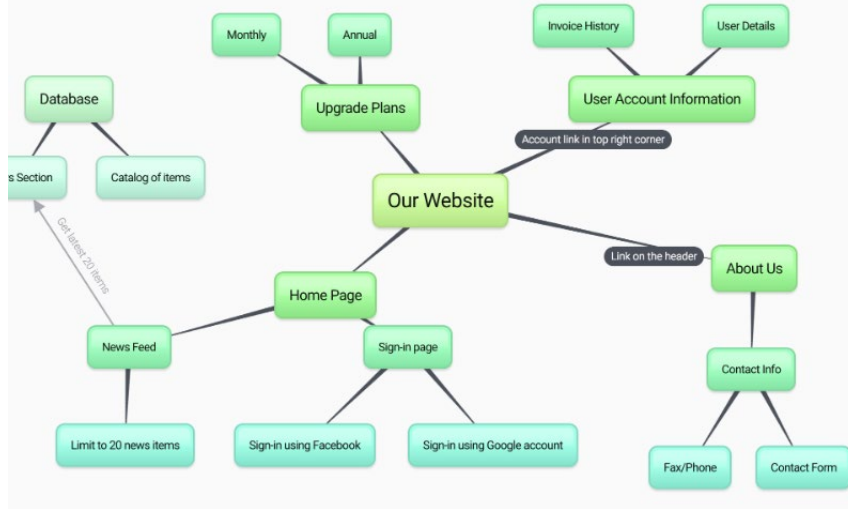

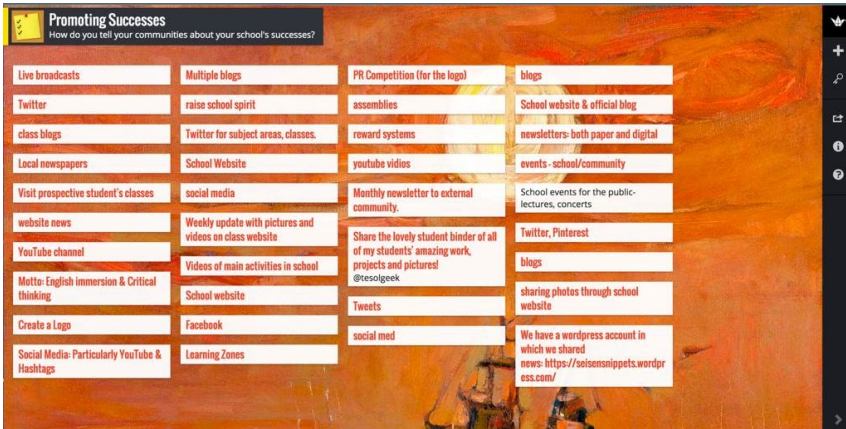
